## **General Considerations**

- · Disconnect power before installing, adding or changing any component.
- · To avoid a hazard to children, account for all parts and destroy all packing materials.
- · Do not install any luminaire assembly closer than 6" from any combustible materials.
- · Max voltage: 12V DC ± 20%
- 1. Place light in location to be installed. Pre drill mounting holes with 1/8" bit. Then mark the wire exit hole location and drill 1/4" hole for wire exit.



**3.** Use the Phillips screwdriver to tighten the porch light into place.



**5.** If the light ever needs to be removed. The bezel will snap off using a flat head screwdriver in the slot on the side of the light. LED light source is not replaceable.



**2.** Apply a bead of silicone or butyl tape around the backside perimeter of the porch light to seal perimeter to mounting surface.



**4.** Attach the bezel onto the porch light by pushing it on gently until it snaps into place.



**6.** Connect blue wire (+ AM) to power source. Connect black wire (+) (White LED's) to up position on a 3 way switch. Connect blue wire (+) (Amber LED's) to down position on 3 way switch. Connect white wire (-) to ground.

Note: Do not operate amber & white at the same time as it will void warranty. This is why use with a 3 way switch is recommended so it is impossible to turn both colors on at the same time due to circuit board overheating reasons.
